Position Details

This is an ongoing full time teaching position.

St Mary's School is situated in the picturesque, rural farming community of Northampton and is located 50 kilometres north of the regional centre of Geraldton, one hour from the beautiful tourist resort town of Kalbarri and twenty minutes from the peaceful seaside village of Horrocks.

St Mary's School is a co-educational school catering for 50 students from Kindergarten to Year Six. The classrooms are structured as composite year levels and are grouped depending on the number of students enrolled. The school community and the parish community are both interested in, and supportive of, all school activities. The School Board will assist in finding accommodation and help financially with any relocation costs, if required.

The school has a strong focus on the Fruit of the Spirit, Visible Learning, Putting Faces on the Data, integration of ICT across all areas of the curriculum and the environment.

Selection Criteria

- Demonstrate support of the objectives and ethos of Catholic education.
- The capacity and enthusiasm to build community in collaboration with all members of the school community.
- Demonstrate experience in co-ordinating and preparing students for Sacraments.
- Sound knowledge of the Western Australian Curriculum (SCSA) and the ability to apply its content through engaging pedagogy.
- An understanding and use of data-driven teaching and learning.
- Excellent teaching and classroom management skills.
- An ability to use and integrate ICT into all aspects of teaching and learning.
- Excellent interpersonal and organisational skills.
- A strong commitment to team work with a commitment to continual learning and improvement.
- An ability to differentiate the curriculum to cater for the individual needs of the students in the classroom.

Qualifications Required

- Relevant four year tertiary qualification
- Have or be willing to attain Accreditation to Teach Religious Education
- Active membership of the Catholic Church

Applicants must submit a curriculum vitae, addressed to the Principal, including the names and contact numbers of three referees, one of whom must be the current employer and a Parish Priest. Applicants must have a current registration as a teacher with the Teacher Registration Board of WA (TRBWA) to be eligible for appointment. Information is available from the TRBWA website.

Applicants must be fully supportive of the objectives and ethos of Catholic education.
