Early Years Learning Framework - EYLF

At St Mary's School, the Early Education staff use the EYLF to ensure that your child receives a high-quality experience. The EYLF was created and trialed by experienced early childhood educators, academics, parents and carers. The EYLF focuses on your child's learning. The staff will work with you in order to get to know your child well. They create a learning program that builds on your child's interests and abilities and keeps you in touch with your child's progress.

Through the Framework's five learning goals, educators will assist your child to develop:

- a strong sense of their identity
- connections with their world
- a strong sense of wellbeing
- confidence and involvement in their learning
- effective communication skills





Lenten Prayer: God of all peoples and nations, as you accompany us


